# 2022 VA Ancillary Benefits Increased and VA Disability Compensation Rates

Effective October 1, 2020 the rates have increased for the Department of Veteran's Affair ancillary benefits. In order to be



eligible for one or more of the ancillary benefits you must have a qualifying service-connected disability. For those of you that are entitled to the ancillary benefits, the new fiscal year 2020 amounts are listed below.

Specially Adaptive Housing (SAH) Grant: \$101,754.00 Special Housing Adaptation (SHA) Grant: \$20,387.00

SAH Temporary Residence Adaptation (TRA) Grant: \$40,983.00

SHA Temporary Residence Adaptation (TRA) Grant: \$7,318.00

Auto and Adaptive Equipment Grant: \$22,355.42

Clothing Allowance: 891.00

Medal of Honor pension: \$1489.73

In addition, Effective December 1, 2021 your monthly Veterans disability compensation rates have gone up. If you are rated at 100% or below you can look up your new monthly benefit amount on <a href="https://www.va.gov/disability/compensation-rates/veteran-rates/">https://www.va.gov/disability/compensation-rates/</a>. 




## **Hooked on Autographs**

#### VA COMMUNITY CARE: BOWEL & BLADDER PROGRAM

#### **PROGRAM**

- All potential caregivers must be referred to the Bowel and Bladder Coordinator by SCI medical provider, followed by an interview to assess needs of the patient
- Caregiver must be authorized and have a start date prior to starting care

#### REGISTRATION

- Payments are taxable, new caregivers must fill out the following documents:
  - VA-FSC Vendor File Request Form 10091
  - ➤ W-9 forms
  - VCA signed agreement
  - NPI application (may take 2-3 days receive your 10-digit NPI number)
- Submit all documents to
  - VA Community Care Austin Texas
  - Your appropriate VA Community Care SCI Spoke Site Representative according to where you live (See SCI Spoke Site Representatives below)
- Caregiver's initial first payment will be 2-3 months after submitting timesheets

#### **TIMESHEETS**

- Be consistent and claim the same time number of hour and minutes everyday
- If there are (2) caregivers working the same day, claim hours on (2) different days
  - Caregivers cannot share the same day and time on timesheets
- Services can only be claimed when Veteran is at home (excludes hospitalization or facility care)
- Make a copy and save all timesheets for your records and taxes
- . Send in your monthly timesheet on the last day of the month and print your 10-digit NPI number on the timesheet
